Habitat

Native to the rainforests of Indonesia and Papua New Guinea.

Care

Charmander likes to tuck into a mix of high protein foods, veggies and fruit. He particularly loves snails, insects, cooked chicken, eggs, blue berries and bananas.

Charmander is now happily settled into living his own large vivarium. He has lots of log hides to clamber under and over, a heat lamp for daily 'sunbathing' and a UVB strip light to help his bones stay strong.

Charmander is a merauke blue tongue skink and is native to the rainforests of from Indonesia. He needs high humidity to help him shed his skin properly, which he does fairly regularly. This lets him grow bigger and helps keep him healthy.

Charmander is friendly and gentle, and likes to pretend to be a parrot, merrily climbing up people to sit on their shoulders.
